"The Fremont" Leather Drawer Pull **Installation Instructions**

- First, you'll need to drill a hole using a 7/32" drill bit. I recommend marking the hole first with a smaller pilot hole using an 1/8" drill bit.
- Take a look at your hardware. The hardware provided includes two screws, choose the one that fits yours best. The screws are 3/8" and 3/4" long. The shorter 3/8" screw should work great for all single unfaced cabinetry (like IKEA's). The longer 3/4" screw allows the handle to be installed on custom drawers that have two layers of material, a box with a face on it. The washer provides additional support but can be eliminated if you choose.
- Take the leather strap, fold it in a circle with the finished side facing you, lining up the holes so that the finished side of one end is touching the rough backside of the other end to form the handle. If you're installing multiple handles, be sure to fold over the same ends on each handle so that they match (right-to-left or leftto-right...or not, if you prefer that look!).
- Thread the Chicago screw (surfaceless head) through the (optional) washer and the leather straps, and into the hole you drilled in the cabinet.
- Secure from the backside with the included screw of the length that will fit your cabinet. Nicely done!



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




Cabinet surface Washer (optional) Chicago screw Back screw (with internal (different lengths threading) for different cabinet widths)


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


OPTIONAL "FLAT" INSTALLATION: The Fremont can be installed "flat" with 2 points of contact, using an extra hardware kit (sold separately).

Here is our guidance for approximate center-to-center (C2C) dimensions (how far apart to drill the holes):

Size	Recommended C2C Spacing
Small	4.5" (11.4cm) +/- 0.25" (0.6cm)
Large	9" (22.9cm), +/- 0.25" (0.6cm)
Wide	9" (22.9cm), +/- 0.25" (0.6cm)





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
